HIGH SCHOOL SUMMER CAMP 2017 INFO

“Why should my child go to camp?”

Camp is a unique experience that allows your child to step away from everyday distractions. They will be submerged in an environment that allows them to singularly focus on Jesus. This is experienced around the clock through learning from motivating preachers, more quality time with youth pastors and leaders, live passionate worship music, creating deep peer friendships, team-building games, and undivided time to reflect on life and connect with Jesus. The hours spent during camp are equivalent to many months at youth group. We highly encourage this to help jump start your child’s spiritual life with Jesus. Haven or Calvary Nexus does not receive any financial profit for camps, so every penny spent goes directly for the benefit of your child and their hope of having a true and life-changing encounter with Jesus.

“Where is it?”

- Forest Home (near Big Bear, CA). Visit : www.foresthome.org to see the camp site. Calvary Chapel Core LA will be hosting this camp.

“What are the dates and times?”

- August 11-13 (Friday - Sunday)
- Check-in (Fri): 7:30am @ Mobil campus, bus departs 8:30am // Return (Sun): 4pm @ Mobil campus

“Who can go?”

- High school students until all spaces are filled.

“What is the cost?”

- \$215 (early bird price - must pay in full). After July 28th, price will be \$230.

“Where can I make payments?”

- All payments will be made online at www.calvarynexus.org/haven.

“I need financial help. How can my child receive scholarship?”

- Students who have a *true* financial need and have helped with youth group fundraisers will receive priority for scholarships.
- (Scholarship applications must have all questions answered and submitted to request scholarship)
 - Please note: Students will not receive scholarships for the FULL amount.

“How do I register my child?”

A \$50 deposit is due at the time of registration. Only this deposit will officially reserve your student’s spot. **Registration paperwork will be submitted in (2) steps.** (Forest Home is requiring a separate registration process). First, submit the physical forms to the Mobil Front Desk. After submitting your forms, you will receive a link via email on how to register your child online on foresthome.org.

“When is the deadline to register?”

Thursday, August 3rd @ 9pm. (one week before camp) or until all spots are filled. This includes any remaining balance, and all paperwork.

“Can my child bring medications?”

Yes, please have all medications in their original containers with written instructions, and indicate this on the medical release form. This will be given to a qualified camp nurse to administer throughout the duration of camp.

What to Bring

It may be hot or cold, muddy or rainy when you arrive at camp, so be ready for anything.

The Essentials:

- Luggage should be clearly labeled with your name.
- Sleeping bag and pillow. (If accommodations require.)
- Bible (and pens)—be sure your name is in the Bible.
- Bath towel and wash cloth. (If accommodations require.)
- Flashlight: Please be sure to label the flashlight and bring extra batteries.
- General toiletries: soap, toothpaste, toothbrush, shampoo, chapstick, sunscreen, etc.
- Clothing and shoes. (Always be ready to layer for the change of temperature throughout the day, always be prepared with a second pair of shoes.)
- Swimsuits and beach towels. (Ladies, one-piece swimsuits only. Guys, no speedos please.)
- Poncho or other light rain gear: Rain is pretty common. Having waterproof gear of some sort can be helpful if it does happen to rain on us.
- Spending money

Please Note:

All items should be labeled with your name, phone number, and church. It may be wet when you arrive so packing luggage in plastic bags is a great idea.

PLEASE DO NOT BRING THE FOLLOWING ITEMS:

- Weapons, such as knives or any other item designed to hurt someone
- Air Soft Guns
- Cell phones, pagers, radios, PDAs, computers, CD & MP3/iPod players
- Any electronic games including Nintendo DS and other electronic video games
- Sleds, tubes, snowboards or any other large snow toys
- Please, please avoid preventable heartache; do not bring anything that is irreplaceable

General Information:

Camp Security: For the safety of all campers, Forest Home DOES NOT allow visits by anyone other than church staff during camp.

Phone Calls: Forest Home does not make phone service available for campers, except in cases of emergency.

Emergencies: If a loved one needs to reach your family while you are here, they may contact the Forest Home Roundhouse at 909-389-2300 and a message will be given to you.

Easy Fundraiser Ideas:

Did you miss our youth group fundraisers? Don't sweat. You can do it yourself! Here are some suggestions:

1. Sponsorship letters

Write a handwritten letter to close family and friends who may consider donating.

2. Cut grass for your neighbors

On average, some locals will pay as little as \$20 or as much as \$50 to have their grass cut. Cutting a yard 7-15 times will easily pay for camp!

3. Babysitting

An average rate for babysitters is around \$10 per hour. 20 hours of babysitting can cover your camp fees. Consider 3 (6-hour days).

4. Asking friends, neighbors, and family members to pay you to work around their houses and yards.

Most people are willing to donate for youth summer camps, but this can be a way to show your gratitude for the donations of your close friends and family.

5. Yard Sale

Gather items that you can sell. You can even ask friends and family to donate items. Host a yard sale in front of your house. You can also team up with students in your youth group to help boost profit.

6. Pay-as-you-go "Saving"

We've heard that some people say they're not good at saving money. If that discipline isn't easy for you, we encourage you to pay \$20 each week starting June 11th, that works too!
