Participant assumes all risk associated with said transportation, food, and lodging. Participant assumes all liability for allergic reactions, whether disclosed to Nexus S.M.
- Participant hereby agrees to hold harmless and indemnify Nexus S.M. for any injury as the result of negligent, willful or intentional acts of said Participant.

Easy Fundraiser Ideas:

Did you miss our youth group fundraisers? Don't sweat. You can do it yourself! Here are some suggestions:

1.Sponsorship letters

Write a handwritten letter to close family and friends who may consider donating.

2.Cut grass for your neighbors

One average, some locals will pay as little as \$20 or as much as \$50 to have their grass cut. Cutting a yard 7-15 times will easily pay for camp!

3. Babysitting

An average rate for babysitters is around \$10 per hour. 20 hours of babysitting can cover your camp fees. Consider 3 (6- hour days).

4.Asking friends, neighbors, and family members to pay you to work around their houses and yards.

Most people are willing to donate for youth summer camps, but this can be a way to show your gratitude for the donations of your close friends and family.

5. Yard Sale

Gather items that you can sell. You can even ask friends and family to donate items. Host a yard sale in front of your house. You can also team up with students in your youth group to help boost profit.

6.Pay-as-you-go "Saving"

We've heard that some people say they're not good at saving money. If that discipline isn't easy for you, we encourage you to pay \$20 each week starting April 4th, that works too!

What Should I Bring?

What Not to Bring:

- Alcohol
- Tobacco products
- Drugs (Unless prescribed by a doctor and noted in registration forms. Leaders are able to administer OTC medication with guardian approval)
- Firearms, knives, fireworks, etc.

- Nexus staff retains the right to send campers home early if caught with above items listed under "What Not to Bring".
- Any items that do not fit in a suitcase/bag must be approved by the Youth Pastor(s)
