INTRO QUESTION:

Do you remember your first job or crush (puppy love) rejection? Describe how you felt then and what did you learn from this rejection?

THESIS:

God has generally given humanity the freedom of choice. You can thus choose to reject God, you can also recognize and receive Him. Yet, there is also the condition of recognizing and receiving God, but then resisting His leading in your life. The best way to limit regrets in this life, and the life to come, is to yield to God's Spirit.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

Q1. Was there a time in your life when you knowingly rejected Jesus? Describe what your life was like before you received Jesus?

Q2. Describe how you recognized Jesus as your Deliverer and received Him.

Q3. What confirmation have you experienced that you have been delivered (saved)?

Q4. What advice would you give to someone who has received Christ but is now resisting God?

LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR:

1. Who would like to share how they sought to befriend or build relationship with their neighbors inside or outside the group?
2. Are there some needs that can provide us an opportunity to love our neighbors inside or outside the group?

Chat with family and/or friends about some of your experience learning to yield to God.

PRAYER:

1. Praise God for He is our Deliverer.
2. Pray we would continue to pursue non-believers even when we get rejected.
3. Pray we would listen, receive, and yield to His voice.
4. Pray we would belong to a group where we can find accountability from each other.
5. Pray we would seek God's face to have the heart to reach out for people who continue to resist God.
