THESIS:

God uses people to help others become mature disciples. We are called to serve one another in humility and love (Gal. 5:13). Jesus' disciples embrace the blessing and responsibility to serve others, and learn to serve with right attitudes and actions.



INTRODUCTION:

Share with the group a time that someone blessed you by serving you and/or a way that you were able to bless someone else by serving them.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

- Q1. What are some of the right motives for serving God? What are some of the wrong motives?
- Q2. How have you observed or experienced people in your church and/or NG serve as described in the sections above? What did you think or feel about it?
- Q3. What are some of the blessings and burdens that you've experienced as you've sought to serve God by serving others in the context of a local church, or church related ministry?
- Q4. How would you like to apply this lesson in this season of your life?

LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR:

Discipling Idea:

If you haven't already, find a place to serve in your local church. If you are serving, invite someone to join you.

- How have you loved your neighbors inside the group this week?
- How have you loved your neighbors outside of your group this week?

PRAISE AND PRAYER:

- 1. Praise the Lord for His example and his humility and willingness to serve others
- 2. Pray that God would test your heart and show you your motives for serving and align them with Him
- 3. Pray for God to show you how He has gifted you and where He is opening doors for you to serve
- 4. Pray for the Holy Spirit to empower you to "walk worthy of God who calls you into His own kingdom and glory" (v.12)
